Survey Says...

Results from the 2015 CMM In-House/Facility Manager Benchmarking Survey



Last month, we launched the 2015 Cleaning and Maintenance Management (CMM) In-House/Facility Manager Benchmarking Survey to ask our in-house/facility manager readers about current trends and issues affecting their operations and the facilities in which they operate. The information gathered is designed to help you gauge the most impactful trends affecting the market and your industry peers who work in the jansan space. Further, the survey data provides valuable insight for the CMM editorial staff who are looking to better serve you with relevant, educational content.

Methodology and Audience Summary

In April 2015, the survey was distributed by email to members of *CMM*'s in-house/facility manager database, which includes individuals who work in diverse facility types and operations. A total of 378 completed surveys are included in the 2015 analysis.

While this year's survey respondents represented a wide range of facility types overall, more than half (51.6 percent) of participants reported that they work in education facilities (24.9 percent in K-12 schools and 26.2 percent in colleges/universities). More than 31 percent work in health care facilities, while the balance of respondents work in commercial (9 percent), industrial (3.7 percent), hospitality (1.9 percent), recreation/transportation (1.9 percent), and retail (1.3 percent) facilities. More than 90 percent of participants are at the manager level or higher, and 49.2

percent oversee multiple departments—including cleaning and maintenance—at their facilities.

Key Findings

Some of the resonant themes in the survey data may not come as a surprise: In open-ended questions about operational issues impacting in-house professionals, participants consistently mentioned budget pressures, staffing concerns, and infection-control matters. However, when it comes to budgets specifically, 25.1 percent of respondents reported an increased operating budget for 2015, while nearly 40 percent described their operating budget as flat compared to last year.


When asked to rank the importance of specific issues in their facilities and operations, the top five responses that participants ranked as "very important" were health and safety (79.4 percent), improving productivity/efficiencies (78.6 percent), improving facility image (71.4 percent), security (65.3 percent), and staff training/education (65.3 percent).



Have your cleaning/janitorial services been oursourced in the last five years?




OPERATING BUDGET

Describe your 2014-2015 operating budget.



For a second consecutive year, health and safety topped the list of issues that survey respondents ranked "very important" to their facilities/operations.








Q3 Which of the following best describes your management responsibilities?

Q4 In what geographic region is the facility/are the facilities you manage?




Q7 Which of the following best describes your facility(s) type?

Q8 What level of LEED certification has your facility(s) achieved?








Q10 Please select one statement that best describes your 2014-2015 operating budget.






Q11 Please select one statement that best describes your 2014-2015 operating budget in relation to your responsibilities.


Q13 Have your cleaning/janitorial services been outsourced in the last five years?

Q14 Which of the following areas/surfaces are the most problematic in cleaning/maintaining your facility?






Q16 When outsourcing services, do you have input on the specific products and equipment that will be utilized within your facility?




Q17 When selecting an outsourced service provider, what criteria is most important?






Q18 What baseline/benchmarks do you use for expected cleaning task time?






Q19 Which of the following workloading/assignment systems do you use in your facility(s)?






Q20 What type of quality assurances are used in your facility(s)?






Q21 What portable technology do your employees utilize for their job?






Q23 How many full-time employees are in your cleaning/maintenance department?






Q24 How many part-time employees are in your cleaning/maintenance department?






Q25 What is the STARTING hourly wage for employees in your facility(s)?






Q26 What is the AVERAGE hourly wage for employees in your facility(s)?






Q27 What background checks do you use during the hiring process? Check all that apply.






Q28 What type of training do you offer employees in your facility(s)?






Q29 Who provides training for your cleaning/maintenance staff?






Q31 Has your purchasing process changed in recent years?


