Results from the 2020 CMM In-House/Facility Management Benchmarking Survey

e entered 2020 with a tight labor market and the strongest unemployment rates in decades. With this labor shortage, employers have never been more concerned with retention strategies and training their staff to do their jobs well and be part of their team for the long haul. It is not surprising then that employee retention and training were the biggest concerns with cleaning staff among in-house/facility managers who participated in the 2020 CMM In-House/Facility Management Benchmarking Survey.

When asked what issues were important to their facilities and operations, training/education was also among the top five responses that survey participants ranked as important "to a large extent." Health and safety ranked highest, followed by improving facility image, improving productivity/ efficiencies, security, and training/education of staff. An open-ended question about critical issues


facing the facility management industry today revealed similar concerns about qualified staffing, employee retention, and proper training, as well as infection control and budget concerns.

When it comes to operating budgets specifically, 36% of respondents reported an increased budget for 2020, up 11% from 2015 and the same as in 2019. Another one-third (32%) reported a flat budget compared to 2019, still better compared to 40% in 2015. These favorable outlooks reflect the positive economic climate at the end of last year when budgets were made and before the arrival of the novel coronavirus in the U.S in early 2020.

Uncertainties associated with the pandemic are inevitable, but this annual survey is intended to help you plan and prepare the best you can by evaluating your operation regularly, comparing your facility to others, and finding ideas that will help you improve your facility now for future success.


ABOUT THIS REPORT: The data in this survey is based on results from email solicitations sent to the CMM/ISSA community of in-house service providers and facility managers between February 25 and March 13, 2020. A total of 340 completed responses are included in the analysis. Results are self-reported and not necessarily based on audited finance statements.






















Q4 In what state or region is the facility/are the facilities you manage?




Q5 How many buildings/facilities are you responsible for cleaning/maintaining?






Q8 Has your facility achieved LEED certification?


Q9 If you have achieved LEED certification, what level have you achieved?


Q10 If you have not achieved LEED certification, do you plan on working toward it?






Q13 What percentage of your operating budget is spent on LABOR?







Q23 How many full-time equivalent (FTE) employees work in your cleaning/maintenance department?






Q26 What is your biggest concern with your cleaning staff?


Q33 What percentage of your operating budget is spent on cleaning/maintenance equipment and supplies (purchase and maintenance)?








Q38 Do you utilize autonomous or robotic cleaning equipment?





Q39 To what extent do you purchase cleaning/maintenance products from the following sources?










Q40 What percentage of your cleaning/maintenance products do you purchase ONLINE?






Q44 What do you think is the most critical issue facing the cleaning/facility management industry today?






